Battle of the Bio\Tech Bands – 2027

- Event Date: **Thursday, May 13th 2027. 6:00 PM**
- Location: The Royale. 279 Tremont St. Boston, MA
- Format: 3 bands competing for the title. Each gets approximately 20 minutes on stage in a topnotch venue. Celebrity judges select a “winner”
- Each competing band will take home a portion of the proceeds for their charity of choice.

Criteria for band selection:

- 1) Most band members should be part of a biotech or technology company; (preferred that all band members be from the same company, but not required).
- 2) Quality, appeal, and professionalism of the music.
- 3) Bands should be well-established and accustomed to performing in front of a live audience;
**Cover songs generally go over better with the crowd, as opposed to original music.*
- 4) Ability for the band to bring in corporate sponsors by soliciting their vendors. We also expect the band to rally attendees from within their company and throughout the industry.
- 5) Bands must name a charity for which they will play.

More about the Battle of the Bio\Tech Bands!

The Battle of the Bio\Tech Bands is a networking event unlike any other. More than just a concert, it is a high-energy, community-driven celebration that brings together the life sciences industry through music, networking, and philanthropy. Since its inception in Boston, the event has become a signature gathering for the community, with fundraising efforts supporting charitable organizations selected by each participating band.

In 2026, Battle of the Bio\Tech Bands expanded beyond Boston for the first time with the successful launch of the **West Coast Battle in San Diego**, further extending its mission of connecting the life sciences community while giving back to local charities. The event is now part of the **BoBB Foundation**, the nonprofit organization established to support and grow the Battle of the Bio\Tech Bands and its charitable impact for years to come. Proceeds are generated through the generous support of sponsors and participating companies represented by the bands. Over the past 13 years, Battle of the Bio\Tech Bands has raised more than **\$1.6 million** for charitable organizations, demonstrating the remarkable generosity and collaborative spirit of the bio & tech industries.

Each participating band selects a charity to represent during the competition. At the conclusion of the event, **the "winning" band's charity receives half of the evening's charitable proceeds**, while the remaining proceeds are shared among the charities represented by the other competing bands, ensuring that every performance helps make a meaningful impact.
